1. Introduction

This Cookie Policy explains how Cohort Science Ltd (“Cohort Science”, “we”, “us” or “our”) uses cookies and similar technologies on our websites (including www.cohortscience.org and related sites).

It should be read together with our Privacy Notice and Website Terms of Use.

2. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device (computer, tablet or mobile) when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites work more efficiently and to provide information to the website owners.

Cookies can be:

- **Session cookies** – temporary cookies that expire when you close your browser; or
- **Persistent cookies** – cookies that remain on your device for a set period or until you delete them.

3. How we use cookies

We use cookies for the following purposes:

- **Strictly necessary cookies** – these are essential for the Website to function and cannot be switched off. They are usually set in response to actions you take, such as setting privacy preferences or filling in forms.
- **Performance / analytics cookies** – these help us understand how visitors use the Website so we can improve it (for example, which pages are visited most often).
- **Functionality cookies** – these allow the Website to remember choices you make and provide enhanced features.
- **Targeting / advertising cookies** – these may be set by us or our advertising partners to build a profile of your interests and show you relevant adverts on other sites. These currently require your consent.

4. Cookies we use

The main categories of cookies used on our Website are described below. The specific cookies in use may change over time as we update the Website.

Category	Purpose	Duration	Consent required?
Strictly necessary	Essential site functionality, security, load balancing	Session / short-term	No
Performance / Analytics	Understanding how the Website is used (e.g. Google Analytics or similar)	Up to 2 years	Yes (UK/EEA)
Functionality	Remembering preferences and settings	Up to 1 year	Yes (where required)
Targeting / Advertising	Delivering relevant advertising and measuring campaign performance	Up to 1–2 years	Yes
